

## **Module 8 : CODE Function**

## 8.1 Code Function in Excel

The CODE function, returns a code (numeric) for the first character used in a text string, or to one sole character.

This refers to the character set used by the computer, in case you don't have access to the full character set.

The formula for the CODE Function is the following:

=CODE("text")

If you type =CODE("A"), for example, it will return the number 65, which is the numeric code for most operating systems.
