

Module 44: LEN Function

44.1 LEN Function

You can use the LEN function when you just want to count how many characters there are in a specific text.

You can also use LEN to return a length using numbers and dates, but keep in mind that formatting is not included. For example, \$250.00 will return a length of 3, as it reads as 250. In addition, special characters and spaces will be counted within a text-based cell.

The formula is written as: **=LEN(text) text** *The text being for which to calculate length.*
