## 21.1: Step-by-step Guide

The balloon teddy bear always goes down well with the younger children.

Follow the instructions below to make your own.

#### Step 1

Start by inflating the balloon leaving approximately 2 inches deflated.



Step 2

Starting at the knot end of the balloon pinch and twist a bubble about one to two inches long to make the teddy's nose.



Step 3

The make a circle for the teddy's cheek.



Step 4

Then make another for an ear.




Step 5

Then repeat steps 3 and 4 to make the other ear and cheek areas.



Step 6

Pinch the long part of the balloon and the nose area together and create a lock twist.



Step 7

Grab the nose and push it through the centre of the balloon.



Step 8

Next, grab the second circle...




Lift and twist it...



Step 9

Repeat step 8 on the opposite side of the balloon.



## Step 10

Now make a neck by pinching and twisting an area about and inch or so down from the head area that you have created in the first 9 steps.




Step 11

Then bend the balloon over and create a lock twist which will make an arm.



Step 12

Repeat step 11 again to make another arm.





Step 13

Then make pinch and twist an area to make a "body".



Step 14

Bend the rest of the balloon over and lock twist to create two legs and a tail.
