

Module 33: Insert Serial Number Automatically

33.1 Insert Serial Number Automatically

You can use Excel to automatically assign serial numbers when creating a new field in Excel.

This is done by using a combination of the IF and ISBLANK functions.

First off, use an ISBLANK formula to establish whether a cell is empty and then an IF formula to automatically create a serial number for that field if it is. This formula will always use the data in the cell above, with an addition of one, to create a new serial number. This way you will always have an incremental increase in your serial numbers.

The formula is written as: =IF(ISBLANK(value)," ",value_if_false+1)

Value - This is the cell you want to check for data.

If it is blank it should stay blank.

Value_if_false - this is the cell you wish to select if there is data in our value cell. This is the serial number in the row above +1.
