60.1 Watch Window In Excel

The watch window in Excel is an excellent feature you will be glad to have if you are working with large worksheets with hundreds or even thousands of sets of data.

When working in an especially large workbook you may find it difficult to monitor a few vital cells without wasting a lot of time and effort going back and forth between different areas of information. This is where the watch window is incredibly useful. In a separate window, you will be able to monitor the cells you have selected to watch. You will also be able to see either the formula or the current values at a glance. As a result, you will have no need to keep on scrolling back through your workbook to see those values time and again, making your work more efficient.

To add a Watch Window:-

Go to the Formulas tab and click on Watch Window. You can then highlight the cell you want to watch and click Add Watch.

Just double-click on the relevant details in the Watch Window to get to your chosen cell.
